Students are expected to come to school with proper attention having been given to personal cleanliness, grooming, and neatness of dress. Students whose personal attire or grooming distracts the attention of other students or teachers from their school work shall be required to make the necessary alterations to such attire or grooming before entering the classroom or be sent home by the principal to be properly prepared for school.

MANDATORY UNIFORM as voted on by parents.

The school dress code requirements will be monitored and strictly enforced.

Shirts: Plain Polo style with or without the COPE Logo. Colors: Red, White or Navy Blue

Pants: Bottoms are preferably full length, beige, TWILL pants (for example: Dockers and/or Dickies brands) or plain jeans (navy or black only).

Colors: Black, Navy, Khaki. Absolutely No Shorts.

Shoes: Due to safety concerns, all shoes must have a support strap.

Jackets/Sweaters: Plain jackets or sweaters of any color. Due to safety concerns it is preferred that students wear open front jackets or sweaters as opposed to pullover jackets or sweaters.

Undershirts: Layering will be permitted under the uniform shirt.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE <u>NOT</u> PERMITTED unless pre-approved by the principal.

No dresses, No skirts, No skorts or shorts.

No hats or head covering of any kind. No combs, No rollers.
No bedroom slippers, open sandals without a support strap, or flip flops.
No leggings, yoga pants, sweat pants, pajama pants, cargo-style pants, oversized pants, and/or shorts. NO JEANS with designs, cuts, rips or tears.
